

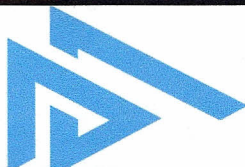
Community Open Day @ Batesford Hub - Wednesday 6th April—3.00 till 7.00 pm

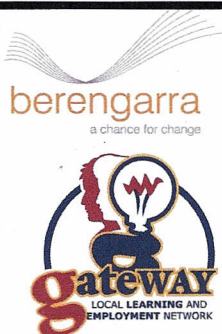
