



## REGISTRATION AND QUALIFICATION INFORMATION

### TEAM REGISTRATIONS

Junior Clubs will complete the WBA team registration form and online team entry and submit with payment on the teams' behalf.

### NEW PLAYER REGISTRATIONS

Additional players joining a team during the season must register their FULL NAME and details on the 'LiveScore Courtside Monitors.' The new players must then register with Basketball Victoria PlayHQ via a registration link provided by their club.

### PLAYER QUALIFICATION / CUT OFF DATES

**SUMMER:** Players must be under the age of the nominated age group by the 30th June in the year in which the season commenced.

**WINTER:** Players must be under the age of the nominated age group by the 31st December in the year before the year in which the season commenced.

### ILLEGAL AND UNREGISTERED PLAYERS

Failing to enter new player details on the LiveScore Monitors, and playing new players under withdrawn or absent player's names renders players ILLEGAL.

Playing people under another person's name, or playing unregistered players is an offence and WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.

Teams found to be illegally playing members will result in the offending team losing that match, and points and the game played will not count towards qualifications. Players will face suspension if caught playing multiple games with no registration.

Ignoring this rule is putting players at risk! No registration means no insurance; therefore, there is no insurance cover for any injuries that occurred during the game by the stadium's insurance group, V Insurance.

If an illegal or suspended player takes the court, this will result in a REPORT and tribunal hearings.

All referee supervisors have the authority to ask for identification if a team queries this rule. Referee supervisors will report to the office any offenders.

## **FINALS QUALIFICATIONS**

Players listed on the LIVESCORE monitors will qualify for the game they are listed. Teams must only list players present and in uniform at the game. Referees will check playing lists at half time and conclusion of matches.

To be eligible to qualify for finals all players must compete in five (5) of the season's non-grading games.

Players replacing other players during the season do not accumulate replaced player's game total.

Teams are responsible for checking noticeboards and website for eligibility of players and team final placing and if they are to play in finals irrespective of position on the ladder.

Any queries must be directed to the office through club officials before the final round of regular-season games. You must submit in writing any questions in regards to the finals before the finals commence.
