Player & Spectator Guidelines




ENTERING THE VENUE

WBA operates under strict restrictions when we return to basketball. As such, we need everyone involved to work together and follow our directives.


The first step in keeping everyone safe is if you are unwell, please stay at home.

DO NOT ENTER

If you have any of the following symptoms:











PLEASE STAY AT HOME IF UNWELL

FACE MASKS

Face masks must be worn by everyone (except players under 12 years or people with a lawful exemption) throughout our stadiums.

Players will be allowed to remove face masks when they go on to the court to start warm-up.

Once a game or training has ended, players must then apply the face mask once again.

All spectators, coaches and managers must keep their face covering on throughout their time in the stadium.



ENTRY, EXIT & TOILETS

DO NOT arrive more than 10 minutes before your training session or game.

Exit the venue within 5 minutes of your training session or game ends.

If you arrive early, wait in your car until you can enter.

Do not wait at or near the entrance of the stadium.

Upon entry into the stadium, please maintain social distancing until the commencement of your training session or game.

When you arrive, **EVERYONE** who enters any stadium must check-in.

- That means participants, family members of participants, staff/volunteers and coaches.

ONCE YOU GET INSIDE

Complete the following steps:

- 1. Sanitise your basketball (if applicable)
 - 2. Sanitise your hands
- 3. Follow social distancing rules and proceed to your court

KIOSK

If you would like to utilise the Kiosk or the vending machines, you must adhere to social distancing regulations.

You will see signage around the stadiums and on floors to help you with this.

PLEASE PAY WITH EFTPOS WHEREVER POSSIBLE.

Please note the Canteen will only be open on game day for the following days Friday, Saturday And Sunday.

PARENTS & GUARDIANS

Due to State Government and basketball Victoria restrictions It is highly likely that Waverley Basketball will have to put a limit on the number of spectators.

BIO SAFETY OFFICERS

Stadiums will have biosafety officers working at all times. They will be easily identifiable in hi-vis clothing. It is their job to ensure the stadium is sanitised both during and between sessions. Please follow their requests.

If an area exceeds the total amount of people allowed, they have the right to ask you to move.

IF YOU OR A FAMILY MEMBER TEST POSITIVE

Once you have followed the advice of the government's COVID-19 Hotline and your GP, it is imperative that you contact Waverley Basketball.

You will need to advise us of the time and date you were in the venue and what court you were on.

RETURN TO BASKETBALL CHEAT SHEET

- 1. Stay home if you are unwell. Especially if you have a fever, are coughing, feeling fatigued, have shortness of breath or a sore throat.
- 2. Do not arrive early, and if you do stay in your car.
- 3. Enter and exit through the correct sections.
- 4. Check-in
- 5. Sanitise your ball and your hands.
- 6. Maintain social distancing in the stadium.
- 7. Adhere to spectator limitations, details to be announced.
- 8. Listen to staff and bio-safety officers at all times.
- 9. Depart within 5 minutes of your session ending.
- 10. If you test positive, notify us immediately
